

The provided text is the Jewish prayer Avinu Malkeinu (Our Father, Our King), a supplication recited during the Ten Days of Awe, between Rosh Hashanah (the Jewish New Year) and Yom Kippur (Day of Atonement). This prayer asks for God's mercy, forgiveness, and protection, invoking God as both a loving parent and a sovereign ruler to petition for a good new year, nullification of evil decrees, and inscription in the "Book of Life".

Our Father, our King, we have sinned before You.

Our Father, our King, we have no King but You.

Our Father, our King, deal with us for the sake of Your name.

Our Father, our King, may the new year be good for us.

Our Father, our King, nullify all evil decrees against us.

Our Father, our King, render the counsel of our enemies of no effect.

Our Father, our King, nullify the designs of those who hate us.

Our Father, our King, nullify the designs of those who hate us.

Our Father, our King, close the mouths of our adversaries and accusers.

Our Father, our King, overcome our oppressors and adversaries.

Our Father, our King, withhold plague from Your inheritance.

Our Father, our King, forgive and pardon all our iniquities.

Our Father, our King, blot out our transgressions from before Your eyes.

Our Father, our King, return us in repentance to You.

Our Father, our King, destroy the evil judgment decreed against us.

Our Father, our King, let Your remembrance of us be for good.

Our Father, our King, inscribe us in the book* of good life. *(Jewish tradition teaches that God opens books of judgment on Rosh HaShana and closes them on Yom Kippur.)

Our Father, our King, inscribe us in the book of redemption and salvation.

Our Father, our King, inscribe us in the book of maintenance and sustenance.

Our Father, our King, inscribe us in the book of merit.

Our Father, our King, inscribe us in the book of forgiveness and pardon.

Our Father, our King, let salvation soon spring forth for us.

Our Father, our King, raise up the strength of Israel, Your people.

Our Father, our King, raise up the strength of Your Anointed.

Our Father, our King, fill our storehouses with plenty.

Our Father, our King, hear our voice, spare us and have mercy on us.

Our Father, our King, receive our prayer with mercy and with favor.

Our Father, our King, open the gates of heaven to our prayer.

Our Father, our King, turn us not back empty from Your presence.

Our Father, our King, remember that we are but dust.

Our Father, our King, have compassion on us, our children and infants.

Our Father, our King, do this for the sake of those slain for Your sake.

Our Father, our King, do it for Your sake, if not for ours.

Our Father, our King, do it for Your sake and save us.

Our Father, our King, do it for the sake of Your Name by which we are called.

Our Father, our King, be gracious to us and answer us, for we have no good works of our own; deal with us mercifully and save us.

DAY 1: Prayer for Repentance Scripture:

1 John 1:9 – "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

Prayer: Heavenly Father, today I come before You in humility, acknowledging my need for repentance. I ask You to reveal anything in my heart that displeases You. Forgive me for the times I have strayed from Your ways. Cleanse me and restore my heart to be fully aligned with Your will and purpose. In this 10 days of Awe as we corporately pray together transform us, our church and our city. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Prayer for Repentance in NYC Scripture:

Joel 2:12-13 – "Even now," declares the Lord, "return to Me with all your heart, with fasting and weeping and mourning."

Prayer: Jesus, fill our church with wisdom and understanding as we come before You bringing to You our church and the families that are here. May the eyes of Gateway City Church be opened and You would bring GCC into a new season of grace to fulfill the calling.

Lord, we lift up the NYC to You. We pray that the hearts of the people would turn back to You in repentance. Send the Spirit of repentance to NYC. Reveal to the people of NYC Your love and mercy, and lead them to seek You with all their hearts. May the people of NYC come to know the forgiveness and salvation that is found in You alone. In Jesus Name. Amen.

We bring before you the Mayoral election for NYC and we pray that you would bring to the Mayoral office a righteous leader. A leader after Your heart that would lead this city into a great outpouring. We declare that all agendas that are contrary to God's will for the elections in November would fall and fail but the perfect plan that you have would be established.

DAY 2: Prayer for Forgiveness Scripture:

Matthew 6:14-15 – "For if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you."

Prayer: Jesus, just as You have freely forgiven me, help me to forgive those who have wronged me. Release me from bitterness, anger, and grudges. Grant me the grace to offer forgiveness to others, knowing that in doing so, I am reflecting Your love and mercy. In Jesus Name. Amen.

Prayer for Spiritual Awakening in NYC Scripture:

Isaiah 52:8 – "Listen! Your watchmen lift up their voices; together they shout for joy. When the Lord returns to Zion, they will see it with their own eyes."

Prayer: Father, we ask for a great spiritual awakening in NYC. Touch the 5 boroughs with Your overcoming power to see revival come to our city. Open the eyes of the people to see the truth of Your Word and the fulfillment of Your promises in Jesus over our great city. Let their hearts be softened to receive the message of salvation. Pour out Your Spirit over Brooklyn, Manhattan, Bronx, Staten Island and Queens, and draw the people who live in our borders closer to You.

Jesus bring GCC into a new season of Revival that would bring in a great harvest of souls for the Kingdom. Give every person in Gateway City Church eyes to see and ears to hear what You are speaking to them and this local body in this season. May GCC experience a new anointing for a new day that will thrust the church to see signs, miracles and wonders. In Jesus Name. Amen.

God would You give voters from NYC wisdom from heaven so that they can be sincere in voting for the right person for Mayor. That young generation of voters and first-time voters would feel the leading of the Holy Spirit that empowers them

to make the right choice when it come the mayoral election in NYC. That the voters make decisions with godly wisdom, led by the Holy Spirit. In the Name of Christ.

DAY 3: Prayer for Reflection Scripture:

Psalm 139:23-24 – "Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting."

Prayer: Father, I invite You to search my heart today. Look deep into my heart and remove everything that does not align to Your plans and purpose for me. Reveal to me the areas where I need to grow, repent, and change. Help me to see myself through Your eyes, not in condemnation, but in love, so I can live in a way that honors You. In Christ's Name. Amen.

Prayer for Peace in NYC and Jerusalem Scripture:

Psalm 122:6 – "Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: 'May those who love you be secure.'"

Prayer: God of Israel, we pray for peace in Jerusalem and NYC, the cities of Your promise. Let there be peace within the wall of our 5 boroughs and in Jerusalem. May our cities walls be built on unity, love and peace among the church and the people that live in it. We ask that You protect Israel, protect Brooklyn, Staten Island, Manhattan, Bronx and Queens from harm and guide its leaders toward wisdom and justice. Above all, may the Prince of Peace reign in the hearts of all who live in NYC and Jerusalem. Watch over the nations and bring Your rule and reign in the season. In the wonderful Name of Jesus. Amen.

DAY 4: Prayer for Renewal Scripture:

Romans 12:2 – "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind."

Prayer: Holy Spirit, I ask You to renew my mind and heart today. Transform my thoughts, attitudes, and desires so that they align with Your Word, Your Will and Your purpose for my life. Help me walk in the newness of life, empowered by Your Spirit to reflect Jesus Christ in all I do and say. In Christ's powerful and wonderful Name. Amen.

Prayer for Israel's Recognition of the Messiah Scripture:

Romans 10:1 – "Brothers, my heart's desire and prayer to God for the Israelites is that they may be saved."

Prayer: Lord, we pray for the people of Israel to recognize Jesus as their promised Messiah. Open their hearts to the truth of the Scriptures and the fulfillment of the prophecies. May they see that the One they have waited for has already come, and may they embrace the salvation offered through Christ. As we lift up Israel in prayer we ask that You would save NYC. Your Word says that ***"No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws them, and I will raise them up at the last day."*** ***John 6:44*** Father would You send Your Holy Spirit to draw all men in NYC to You. May there be a tugging in the hearts of the people to come to Jesus Christ and may we see a great harvest of souls in this city.

We pray where there is division in NYC during this election, that You would bring unity and respect. We come against lies and false narratives that are being released over our airways for this election, God would You bring revelation and truth. That where there is despair, God would You bring hope and vision. God may the right person be placed as the Mayor over NYC. In Jesus Name.

DAY 5: Prayer for God's Mercy Scripture:

Lamentations 3:22-23 – "The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning."

Prayer: Gracious Heavenly God, I thank You for Your endless mercies that are new every morning. Though we fall short, Your compassion never fails. I ask for Your mercy to flow over my life, my family, and my GCC church family. May Your grace continue to guide me and sustain me every day. In the wonderful Name of Jesus. Amen.

Prayer for the Outpouring of the Holy Spirit Scripture:

Joel 2:28 – "And afterward, I will pour out My Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions."

Prayer: Holy Spirit, we pray for a mighty outpouring of Your presence over Gateway City Church. Just as You promised, pour out Your Spirit on all people, bringing dreams, visions, and prophetic words that lead to salvation. Stir a hunger for You in the hearts of all who live in our city. Revive our land. Bring Holy desperation for God's glory and presence to our church and city. Open up the windows of heaven and pour out a blessing over our church that cannot be contained in the hour. In Jesus Name. Amen.

May God establish a government of justice and righteousness in NYC through the election coming up. That all forms of injustice and corruption are exposed and destroyed by the power of God. That those righteous leaders in NYC actively fight against all forms of oppression and discrimination, allowing freedom to flourish In Jesus Name. That mercy and compassion for all people are restored in laws, policies, and the hearts of the people living in NYC.

DAY 6: Prayer for Reconciliation Scripture:

2 Corinthians 5:18 – "All this is from God, who through Messiah reconciled us to Himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation."

Prayer: Lord, as You have reconciled me to Yourself through Your Son Jesus, help me to seek reconciliation with others. Heal broken relationships in my life, and give me the courage to pursue peace, forgiveness, and understanding with those around me. In Christ Name. Amen.

Prayer for Unity Among Believers Scripture:

Ezekiel 37:22 – "I will make them one nation in the land, on the mountains of Israel, and one king will be king over all of them."

Prayer: God of Israel, we pray for unity among the believers, in our wonderful city. Strengthen the body of Jesus, both Jewish and Gentile that live in NYC, to stand together as a powerful witness to Your love and grace. May our unity amongst the leaders of NYC be a light that draws others to salvation and healing in Your Name. May we come to a place in Jesus that we as the body of Christ in NYC work together and bring glory to God by uniting, praying and co-laboring together with the sole purpose of bringing God's Kingdom to NYC as in Heaven. In Jesus Name. Amen.

DAY 7: Prayer for Humility Scripture:

Philippians 2:3 – "Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves."

Prayer: Jesus, You demonstrated the ultimate humility by coming to earth and serving us. Teach us to walk in humility, considering others above ourselves. Help us to reflect Your servant heart in our actions and attitudes toward others. In Jesus Name. Amen.

Prayer for Protection Over the church and our city Scripture: Psalm 121:4 –

"Indeed, He who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep."

Prayer: Lord, we ask for Your divine protection over Gateway City church. Guard its borders, protect its people from harm, and watch over the land as a faithful guardian. Send Angelic help from the sanctuary of heaven. May the Angels watch over all the plans and purposes of God in GCC. May Gateway be protected from every scheme of the enemy and be hidden in the presence of God as in the day of Moses when the cloud hid the children of Israel. May the fire of God's Spirit guide GCC and bring protection in the night hours. Let Your hand of protection rest over the NYC and the nations, and may GCC enemies be thwarted in their plans. In times of trouble, may the people turn to You for refuge. In Jesus Name. Amen.

God bless this election with Your truth, justice, wisdom and grace. God would You give our political leaders in NYC a heart for unity and peace. That God would intervene to bring the right leaders who will best serve Your vision and have Your heart for our City. God will You raise up righteous leaders who are trustworthy, ethical, and pure of heart to govern NYC. In Christ's Name.

DAY 8: Prayer for God's Guidance Scripture:

Proverbs 3:5-6 – "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make straight your paths."

Prayer: Father, I seek Your guidance today and in the days ahead. I trust in Your wisdom and not my own understanding. Direct my steps, show me the path You would have me walk, and give me the confidence to follow wherever You lead. Amen.

Prayer for the Fulfillment of God's Promises to GCC Scripture:

Jeremiah 29:11 – "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

Prayer: Father, we trust in the promises you have made and the prophetic words You have spoken to GCC. We pray for their fulfillment in every way, for the future You have declared over Gateway to come to pass, and for the destiny that has been spoken over GCC to fully manifest in this season. May the people of GCC experience the fulfillment of Your Word through the manifest power of the Holy Spirit in their lives, and may Your blessings flow upon GCC and them. In the wonderful Name of Jesus. Amen.

Lord would you over turn the agenda of bringing socialism in NYC. We release freedom to rule and reign through Jesus Christ in NYC during the next few month while decision are being made by voters. DAY 9: Prayer for Holiness Scripture:

1 Peter 1:15-16 – "But just as He who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: 'Be holy, because I am holy.'"

Prayer: Lord, You call me to live a life of holiness, set apart for Your purposes. Help me to strive for purity in my heart, thoughts, actions, and words. Fill me with Your Holy Spirit to overflow so that I may be a vessel of Your glory and love. In Your Name Jesus. Amen.

Prayer for the Remnant Scripture:

Romans 11:5 – "So too, at the present time there is a remnant chosen by grace."

Prayer: Lord, we pray for the remnant of believers here NYC who have accepted the call to serve You wholeheartedly. Strengthen our faith as one body in NYC and give us courage to bring the Good News of Jesus Christ together to every sphere of influence that we at GCC have in our city. May we as the GCC community be the light in the darkness, pointing every one not saved to Your truth and life in Jesus. Amen.

DAY 10: Prayer for Atonement and Salvation Scripture:

Romans 5:8 – "But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Messiah Yeshua died for us."

Prayer: Loving Father, I thank You for the gift of atonement through the sacrifice of Messiah Jesus Christ . You have made a way for me to be forgiven and redeemed through the sacrifice of Jesus Christ on the cross. I thank you for Your Son's sacrifice of the shedding of His Blood that washes me clean. I commit my life to You, fully trusting in Your grace and salvation. May my life be a testimony to Your love and sacrifice. In Christ Name. Amen.

Prayer for the Restoration of All things Scripture:

Romans 11:26 – "And in this way all Israel will be saved, as it is written: 'The Deliverer will come from Zion; He will turn godlessness away from Jacob.'"

Prayer: Father, we long for the day when all Israel will be saved. When all the nations will come to Your light and glory. We pray for the full restoration of Your people, of the nations and our city to You, as You have promised in Your Word. May every heart come to know the Deliverer, and may the nation be restored to its place as a light to the world through the salvation You offer. In Christ's Name, Amen.

Father, we know that all authority comes from You. We pray that Your will be done in the upcoming Mayoral election. We ask that You place the men who love You and seek You in a position of authority over NYC and that You will give them strength and wisdom to stand in the gap for Your people. We ask for those candidates and officials who do not know Your saving grace that they would receive Your salvation, love, and guidance. We pray this in Christ's Name, Amen.
